SOLVED

Please open the following file: `/etc/init.d/mountdevsubfs.sh` by following command - `gksudo gedit /etc/init.d/mountdevsubfs.sh`

Find the following lines:

```
#mkdir -p /dev/bus/usb/.usbfs
```

```
#domount usbfs "" /dev/bus/usb/.usbfs -obusmode=0700,devmode=0600,listmode=0644
```

```
#ln -s .usbfs/devices /dev/bus/usb/devices
```

```
#mount --rbind /dev/bus/usb /proc/bus/usb
```

Unmark them so that look like this:

```
mkdir -p /dev/bus/usb/.usbfs
```

```
domount usbfs "" /dev/bus/usb/.usbfs -obusmode=0700,devmode=0600,listmode=0644
```

```
ln -s .usbfs/devices /dev/bus/usb/devices
```

```
mount --rbind /dev/bus/usb /proc/bus/usb
```

Restart and your usb devices will be recognised
