However, vmware will not let it run because I keep getting "questions" about failed operations and such that I have to answer Abort, Continue or Retry. I expect such errors, and I simply want vmware to Continue without prompting me every time. Is there a way to disable such prompting and just let the vm run normally? Thanks..
