Just installed VMware 1.0.8 on a Fedora Core 10 64 bits.

All is running smoothly.

Restored a VM from a vmware server 1.0.6 and all ok -> machine up and with conectivity ! Yessss

Then decided to restore the other VM and it booted ok ! Still with no connectivity.

The network interface is bridged with the fisical network and the only thin strange that I get is, when I boot this second machine the /var/log/messages shows up with this message:

several times and with no regular time interval 😞

and no conectivity 😞

Do you guys have any hint what might it be ?

appear on the var/log/messages of the phisical machine not from the Virtual one.
