

# Problems with Workstation 6.5 on Ubuntu ...

Jan 31, 2009 After upgrading to Ubuntu 8.10, I've had multiple issues that I have been able to solve by searching these forums.

Here is a brief summary (XP Pro guest with VM Tools) :

1. Guest pegs my CPU's at 100% (Intel Core2 Duo core). Solution - Set guest to run on 1 CPU.
2. Slow guest performance. Solution - Move VM Image from NTFS File system to Fat23 or ext3 file system.
3. Incorrect key mapping. Action - Add `xkeymap.nokeycodeMap = true` to the config file as per this link: <http://communities.vmware.com/thread/177321>.
4. Changing the Config file causes Unity Mode to crash. Action/Solution - Remove the new line from config and add individual key maps as outlined in this thread: <http://communities.vmware.com/thread/178566?tstart=15>.

Now unity works and the key mapping while in console mode or full screen mode work fine, but the Key mapping in Unity mode does no work. Any ideas?
