When I hit the "test" button, quite immediately an error appears: "Array with key 'Our\_HP\_EVA5000' not found. And then the recovery plan ends with errors.

I checked the HP virtualization adapter logs for licensing errors but it looks clean. The SRM log doesn't show me anything useful I can work with.

Ideas anyone? Should I report this to HP?

I don't get any clues from your log snippet, so I would suggest that you call your support. It might be VMware if you purchased VMware support, or it might be HP. In either case, make sure to provide your SRM logs to them as it will make sure they can help you out faster.

And if you could post here the solution that would be great help for everyone else.
