It prompts me for a hot fix for scsiport.sys but everything is up to date in windows update and I can't find a download for a more recent one than 12/29/2004. The process fails at 100% when it begins the post-processing.

You will find it in C:\Windows\system32\drivers, at least that is where I found it.

I was able to get a new file by reapplying Win2k SP4 rollup 1. Once I did that I stopped getting the scsiport.sys errors. I had to manually download and reapply the rollup, even though i had it previously installed to get the updated scsiport.sys file.

After converting the machine you have to install the VMware tools and everything works fine.
