## Preface

This document details the components that are installed by the PCoIP® Component Installer. Note that Administrator Rights are required in order for the Installer to run successfully.

# 1 Release 1.0.1

This section provides a brief summary of the capabilities for the PCoIP Component Installer release 1.0.1.6342.

## 1.1 Compatibility

The PCoIP Component Installer will only run on systems that have VMware View™ Agent 4.5 (or greater) already installed. The installer will fail if VMware View™ Agent 4.5 (or greater) is not detected.

The PCoIP Component Installer has been verified on the following OS:

- Microsoft Windows XP 32 bit
- Microsoft Windows 7 32 bit
- Microsoft Windows 7 64 bit

## 1.2 Installation Components

### 1.2.1 Teradici Virtual Audio Driver 1.0.0.5707

#### Description:

The WHQL signed *Teradici Virtual Audio Driver* provides the additional functionality of analog audio input on the client. This driver supersedes the *VMware Virtual Audio Driver (DevTap)* that is provided with the VMware View 4.5 installer.

**Agent Install Only:** Yes

**Optional:** No

#### Post Installation Instructions:

After installation, you need to verify that the *Teradici Virtual Audio Driver* is the default playback and recording device under Control Panel (Sounds). Once confirming this, you need to restart the OS.

#### Uninstallation Instructions:

To uninstall the *Teradici Virtual Audio Driver*, go to Windows Device Manager and delete the *Teradici Virtual Audio Driver* under *Sound, video and game controllers*.

#### Notes:

1. Each time the PCoIP Component Installer is run, any existing *Teradici Virtual Audio Driver* is deleted and then reinstalled again (which will require an OS reboot).
2. If the *Teradici Virtual Audio Driver* is disabled and re-enabled, you will need to restart the PCoIP Session (i.e. reboot the OS or log off and log on again).
3. This *Teradici Virtual Audio Driver* supersedes the non-WHQL signed Teradici Audio Driver version 1.0.0.5452 that was released as part of the beta program.
4. Ignore the “Windows Program Compatibility Assist” message at end of install.
