

# VMware View Client for iPad Release Notes

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These release notes cover the following topics:

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## Key Features

VMware View Client for iPad makes it easy to access your Windows virtual desktop from your iPad with the best possible user experience on the Local Area Network (LAN) or across a Wide Area Network (WAN).

- Work the way you want to - Use your iPad to work on your Windows-based VMware View virtual desktop from any location. Support for the PCoIP display protocol from VMware means your desktop is fast and responsive regardless of where you are.
- Best of both worlds - View Client supports native iPad gestures for quick and easy navigation around your desktop. Need to do something more complex? Use the onscreen trackpad for better mouse targeting or use the onscreen arrow keys for efficient text input.
- Simple connectivity - View Client for iPad is tightly integrated with the VMware View 4.6 release for simple setup and connectivity. Quickly reconnect to your desktop by selecting from the recent desktop list.
- Unmatched performance - The adaptive capabilities of the PCoIP protocol are optimized to deliver the best user experience, even over low-bandwidth and high-latency connections.
- Secure from any location - At your desk or away from the office your data is always secure. Access your View desktop over Wi-Fi or 3G, and with tight VMware View 4.6 integration your desktop is delivered securely to you wherever you are.


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## Internationalization

The user interface for View Client for iPad is available only in English, and only English-language keyboards are supported.

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## Before You Begin

- VMware View Client for iPad is supported with VMware View 4.6 or later.
- Install and upgrade View Client for iPad just as you do any other iPad app, by going to the Apple App Store.

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## Known Issues

- Multitasking is not supported. If you double-click the Home button to switch to another application, you are disconnected from the View desktop. When you return to View Client, you need to reconnect to your View desktop.
- On your iPad, if your View desktop does not load, or if you see the message, "Your desktop is loading too slowly,"

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check with your View administrator. You might need to turn on your VPN, or the administrator might need to enable the PCoIP Secure Gateway component in the security server or View Connection Server instance that View Client for iPad connects to.

- In order for the View desktop display to autofit the iPad screen when you rotate the iPad, you must power the virtual machine off and then power it on. That is, after the desktop pool is created, the administrator must use vSphere Client or some other means to power off and then on the virtual machine that will be used as a View desktop on an iPad.
- In a View desktop, setting the mouse pointer to "Display pointer trails" is not supported. If you attempt to use this setting, you might see two mouse pointers, with one overlapping the other. In certain circumstances, the two overlapped mouse pointers might have different shapes.

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
