Hands on Labs 1 of 2

(HOL = Hands on Lab)

A **free** resource that is available to anyone that wants to learn about any VMware technology including NSX. The Hands on Labs provide a great way to get some hands on experience. Which is great for self-learning and certification. These are real environments, that are created and deployed solely for the person requesting them. So you can use these environments to test your own scenario's as well.

You get 1.5 - 2.5 hours per lab, but this can be extended in 30 mins slots, up to 8 hours. The maximum time is reduced when VMworld is taking place. You can also do a lab as many times as you like. FYI, I have started, and completed HOL 1625 approx. 130 times, as I used it as a customer demo environment.




